 - i. Department of Labor Defining and delimiting the exemptions for executive, administrative, professional, outside sales and computer employees
 - ii. Fair Labor Standards Act Minimum wage, 40-hour work week, overtime, compensable time, exemptions from overtime.
 - iii. All positions are eligible for overtime EAP category executive, administrative and professionals, exceptions:
 - 1. Duties test
 - 2. Minimum salary threshold
 - iv. Currently the threshold \$684 per week
 - 1. S&T \$47,476 is the threshold for UM System
 - v. New minimum/threshold:
 - 1. July 1, 2024 \$43,888 (\$844 per week)
 - 2. January 1, 2025 \$58,656 (\$1,128 per week)
 - vi. Effects 9E and 10 paygrades.
 - vii. How to determine if a position is exempt from overtime:
 - https://compsearch.umsystem.edu/staff.php
 - 1. FLSA Status: A, E, or P means the new minimum threshold will affect the role.
